Boundary fence

Trish Penman called to advise that the hedge between the hall and adjoining property is being removed. Helen Davidson will conduct a search to confirm boundary. David Stevenson has access to historical mappings of Pukehiki property inclusive of the Hall. Possible that we will have to fund 50% of a new fence depending on outcomes.

Building Project

David Stevenson confirmed that the building consent with DCC would be costed at \$600 and that the builder has quoted on the simplified stage 2 – completion of sub floor re-piling and small retaining wall to support the existing front wall – 37k quoted – John Ware and David Stevenson to visit builder to review options – budget was 20k.

Targa Event

Event is proceeding – marshals are needed to undertake taping etc – max of 16 marshals could provide hall funds of \$500 plus a collection of \$2 from each driver in the competition cars provides us with a further \$400 fund opportunity. Rotary Park Kindy and Lions Club may also be assisting.

Event is Thursday October 30 – 9am – 1.30pm

Cars run one at a time (minute intervals)– approx. 200 cars

Targa's chief safety officer to speak with volunteers to provide training for the event – after review with Targa the date agreed for the meeting is:

Bill and Lennie Allen have volunteered to provide 2 poster boards approx. 1200x1200 advertising the Hoe Down and designed so that they can be used in subsequent years by accommodating date change.
